Educational opportunities abound throughout the festival. Look for these interesting demonstrations you can see everyday of faire.

CHANDLERS were craftsmen that made the main form of lighting things at night. Find out how and from what.

COOKING - A demonstration cooking meat, vegetables, soups, over an open fire.

BAKING - An authentic bakers oven shows how bread was baked during the renaissance era, one loaf at a time.

BLACKSMITHING - Visit the "Dragon Watch Forge" to see how various metals are crafted.
